This policy is designed to clearly communicate our standards of media submissions. We are committed to having an inclusive community embracing different perspectives and viewpoints. We are equally dedicated to providing a safe and productive experience for everyone who participates in AIGA Houston and to treating everyone with respect. Violation of these guidelines may result in your submission being disqualified.

Our policy is as follows:

1. Respect the Community

Your story is welcome. Someone else's identity, work, or culture is not yours to mock, dismiss, or exploit. Hate speech, harassment, bullying, or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.

2. Keep It Professional (But Real)

Authenticity is everything but keep your videos and photos appropriate for a professional, public audience. Refrain from offensive gestures, explicit sexual content, or glorification of violence.

3. Intellectual Property Matters

Only use music, images, or content you create or that you have rights to. Do not use copyrighted material without proof of clearance.

4. Safe & Responsible Sharing

Don't film people without their permission. Avoid showing confidential client work or private spaces that aren't yours to share.

5. High Standards, No Gatekeeping

Every creative has a story. We welcome a range of voices, perspectives, and styles as long as they follow the rules above.
